Tuesday, October 13

Meet your travel companions and the Uptown Social team at the Sheboygan Meijer parking lot to head east. We will have multiple rest stops along the way including lunch and dinner on your own on the way to the hotel.

Wednesday, October 14 – B, D

After enjoying the included continental breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for the Tom Ridge Environmental Center in Erie, PA. Lunch will be on your own on the way. Later in the day, we'll enjoy an included dinner and check into our en route hotel.

Thursday, October 15 – B, D

Today is the last leg of our journey to Boston. We'll have multiple stops throughout the day, including lunch on your own, before our included dinner and check-in at our Boston-area hotel.

Friday, October 16 – B, D

Today we will enjoy a full day guided tour of Boston. We'll see Trinity Church, Boston Common and more. During the tour, we'll stop for a lunch break at world famous waterside attraction Quincy Market & Faneuil Hall Marketplace, enjoying great shopping and more. Afterwards, our guided tour continues with sights such as USS Constitution, the and the Museum of African American History. This evening, we'll enjoy dinner and entertainment before returning to the hotel.

Saturday, October 17 – B, D

After our continental breakfast we'll visit the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum, with permanent exhibits dedicated to First Lady Jacqueline Kennedy, The Space Race, and more. Next, we'll depart for a guided tour of Lexington & Concord. This tour highlights a visit to the Minute Man National Historical Park, the birthplace of the American Revolution. This day is often voted by groups as their favorite part of the trip. We'll end the day with an included dinner before returning to the hotel.

Sunday, October 18 – B, D

Today we'll enjoy our full day guided tour of coastal Massachusetts. We will visit Salem, a city with more than three hundred years of New England history and the site of the infamous Salem Witchcraft Trials. Next, we'll continue the tour onto scenic Cape Ann. There we will visit the vintage New England seaside town of Gloucester, also known as "America's Oldest Seaport". Next we'll visit Rockport, another coastal town with quaint shops, restaurants, and galleries, and an included dinner before we return to the hotel.

Monday, October 19 – B

Monday begins our return to Sheboygan with a visit to Fort Stanwix National Monument in Rome, NY, along the way.

Tuesday, October 20 – B

Today we will stop at the Made in America Store in Elma, NY and stay at an en route hotel.
