Saturday, March 16

Depart in a spacious video and restroom equipped motorcoach and set off for beautiful Savannah, GA. This evening we will stay at an en route hotel.

Sunday, March 17

After a continental breakfast, head to the Kentucky Artisan Center in Berea, KY -- a 20,000 square foot facility where you can explore Kentucky crafts, history, and shop for Kentucky products. Later in the day, enjoy dinner and check into your en route hotel.

Monday, March 18

Enjoy a continental breakfast. Today, you will continue your journey, then enjoy a leisurely dinner and check into a Savannah area hotel for a four night stay.

Tuesday, March 19

After a continental breakfast, you will start your journey with a GUIDED TROLLEY TOUR OF SAVANNAH, the "Belle of Georgia". You'll see extraordinary architectural marvels, beautiful oak-lined streets and lovely "town squares". You will then have HOP ON/HOP OFF Privileges on the trolley for the rest of the day. Enjoy free time on historic River Street, featuring unique 18th century "ballast stone" streets and 19th century cotton warehouses that are now home to fine eateries, unusual shops and antique galleries. Tonight, you'll enjoy dinner with entertainment before returning to your hotel for the evening.

Wednesday, March 20

After enjoying a continental breakfast, you will depart for a GUIDED TOUR OF ST. SIMONS ISLAND. Take a stroll among moss-draped oaks or shop at interesting boutiques and specialty shops in the historic area. Later, you'll take a GUIDED TRAM TOUR OF Jekyll Island. See how the nation's wealthiest citizens like J.P. Morgan and William Rockefeller lived and played - including a stop at what was once the exclusive "Millionaires Club". After dinner, you'll enjoy an evening show at the FAMOUS SAVANNAH THEATRE, then return to your hotel to rest for the next fun-filled day.

Thursday, March 21

Today, after a continental breakfast, enjoy a GUIDED TOUR OF MAGNIFICENT BEAUFORT, SC - "Queen of the Carolina Sea Islands". Beaufort's history dates as far back as the 1500's. Its striking mansions and scenery served as the backdrop for several motion pictures including "The Big Chill" and "Forrest Gump". You'll also tour the Parris Island Marine Base, where 22,000 men and women complete their training annually. Highlights of your tour included the Two Jima Monument, Parade Field and the Parris Island Museum. Tonight, enjoy a nice dinner before returning to your hotel for the evening.

Friday, March 22

Today, after a continental breakfast, you'll make a stop at the South Carolina State Museum in Columbia, SC. Later that day, after dinner, you'll check into an en route hotel.

Saturday, March 23

After continental breakfast, you'll head to the East Tennessee History Center in Knoxville, TN. Tonight relax in your en route hotel room.

Sunday, March 24

Today, after enjoying a continental breakfast, you will depart for home, a perfect time to chat with your friends about all the fun things you've done, the great sights you've seen, and where your next group trip will take you!
